Dr. Rapoport is an associate professor in the department of psychiatry at the University of Toronto, and is an associate scientist at Sunnybrook Research Institute. He is also a member of the Canadian Driving Research Initiative for Vehicular Safety in the Elderly (CanDRIVE), and an associate editor of the Canadian Journal of Geriatrics. Dr. Rapoport received his medical degree from McMaster University in 1995, and completed his residency and fellowship in psychiatry at the University of Toronto, where he now works as a geriatric neuropsychiatrist. He has been a board member of the Canadian Academy of Geriatric Psychiatry (CAGP) since 2006, co-chairing their annual scientific meetings, and was the scientific co-chair for the 2009 International Psychogeriatric Association Congress. His main areas of research are traumatic brain injury in the elderly and the risk of motor vehicle crashes associated with neurological and psychiatric diseases and their treatments.
